
FACILITY MASTER PLAN PURPOSE: FROM STORAGE TO KNOWLEDGE CREATION

Road map for the transformation required to ensure Rush Rhees' ongoing relevance as a state-of-the-art research library in the 21st Century.

Combines broad vision of the University's Strategic Plan with specific aspirations of students, researchers, faculty, and staff.

Identifies solutions to spatial, infrastructural, and operational obstacles that limit flexibility, adaptability and integration.

Proposes a series of discrete projects over time to create a lasting and flexible framework for study and research.






